Pranks

They almost always detract from the spiritual atmosphere of camp. In addition, pranks can escalate, as people and cabins try to “get back at” one another, leading to more serious situations. In the past, campers have been told not to return to camp the next year due to participation in dangerous pranks. Please understand that we are serious about protecting the safety of our campers. Thanks for your cooperation in this.

Roommate Preferences

We will make every effort to accommodate roommate requests. However, please note that in certain cases, large groups of campers from the same church often result in difficult decisions. The typical cabin holds about 12 campers, so sometimes will split larger groups into 2 or 3 different cabins.

Any campers who attempt to change cabin rosters or move to a different cabin without this approval will forfeit their opportunity to be considered for a change!
